The University needed a solution which offered both permit and pay to park options, was easy to manage for our Estates and Commercial Service team and offered a great customer service experience, as parking is a very emotive subject within the university.

Our campuses are spilt site and include two sites within Stoke on Trent city centre and a campus at Stafford. We needed a solution which would be able to provide the same level of service at all locations, which Parkingeye's system provides.

The University also has an Estates Master Plan, which is the strategic plan for site development for the next 5-10 years which involves several changes to the physical estates, impacting on car parking capacity both in the short term and longer term.
